Dear Council Members,

Amid everything you are all doing during Holy Week, there is one pressing piece of business that requires council action via email. Canon Debra Kissinger expects to be downsizing this year, and accordingly to have different housing expenses from what she initially anticipated. Therefore, we need to approve a new housing allowance resolution for her. In the interest of time, I request that you take a vote on the resolution below via email.

From a sequencing standpoint, I will need one council member to move the below text, and another to second it. You may thereafter proceed with the vote. Here is the resolution text:

Whereas the Rev. Canon Debra Kissinger is employed as a minister of the Gospel of the Episcopal Diocese of Indianapolis, which does not provide a residence for her, the Executive Council resolves that of the total compensation to be paid to the Rev. Canon Debra Kissinger during 2018, that \$108,547 be designated as parsonage allowance within the meaning of that term as used in Section 107 of the IRS Code of 1986.

As a reminder, this resolution does not authorize any new expenditure. The resolution is required documentation for Canon Kissinger to be able to prepare her 2018 taxes. Thank you all very much for your prompt attention to this matter during this busy time.
