### Interim Diocesan Youth Minister

The Diocese of Indianapolis seeks an established youth minister to serve in the part-time role of interim diocesan youth minister. This will be a contracted position, intended to begin in the spring/summer of 2022 and to conclude in the fall of 2023.

The person who serves in this role will:

- Convene monthly calls with volunteer and paid youth, family, and children's ministers serving Episcopal churches throughout the diocese for the purpose of sharing questions, ideas, and resources, and collaborating.
- Organize and facilitate a diocesan youth retreat for the fall of 2022, intended for middle school youth throughout the diocese, including: scheduling, preparing for prayer and worship, publicity, recruiting adult and youth leaders, site contracts, budget, etc.
- Facilitate and serve as point person/contact for a diocesan youth pilgrimage or mission trip in the summer of 2023, intended for high school youth throughout the diocese, working with a coordinating agency for this trip.

The ideal candidate will have a deep commitment to their own life of faith. He/she/they will recognize the importance of young people's opportunities to explore and deepen their faith during their middle and high school years. The interim diocesan youth minister will either already have connections, or will have a plan for developing those connections, with youth, family, and children's ministers serving churches throughout the diocese in both volunteer and paid positions. We seek a leader with the proven ability to create a budget, attend to detail, work independently, and communicate robustly.

The interim diocesan youth minister will report to the canon to the ordinary for congregational development and leadership. He/she/they must successfully pass a background check and maintain diocesan Safeguarding training and protocols.
